CITY KIDS

Although we are still in the beginning of 2024, City Kids has already made hundreds of Moments of Impact! Our afterschool students have been receiving the additional educational enrichment needed to help them thrive into scholars. Each week we attend a Creative Writing workshop to help students become greater articulators, writers, and storytellers. We believe that by empowering students outside of the classroom, there is a stronger emphasis on education for them and their families.

These last few months, we have been exploring the idea of influences and choices that students make. Each Friday, we have intentional conversations with middle school and high school students to introduce important topics that can impact their future. Beyond keeping kids out of trouble, our goal is to create fun, safe, and healthy environments for youth to be invested in, and a place for them to discover their purpose.





The Design Lab is City Kid's newest initiative and we are building Moments of Impact that went beyond our expectations. We are thrilled that last year we gave out a total of 25,800 items to the community, with an estimated value of \$668,200. The Design Lab has been a place of hope for families experiencing homelessness, struggling parents, families who needed help in custody cases, students facing bullying or abuse, and so much more. It's more than just "stuff" to give to families; it has allowed us to have genuine conversations with them, being a safe space for them to talk to our staff and find the support they need.

We are excited to be launching our Design Camps coming up this Spring, and we're ready to inspire this next generation of creatives.
